The competition is open to young people up to the ages of 16; it's designed to help promote an early awareness of the local environment - which can be so easily spoilt by litter, vandalism and general degradation. In addition, it's also meant to offer an opportunity for young people to have their abilities recognised at a regional level, on a broader canvas, as it were, as the winning entries will be displayed at the awards ceremony to be held later in the year.

Young people can enter either as individuals, or via schools and clubs, and the theme for this year's competition is **'TREES'**.

#### RULES AND CONDITIONS

2. Schools/Groups

Class 1 Reception, Year 1, 2, 3

Class 2 Year 4, 5, 6

Class 3 Year 7, 8, 9

Class 4 Year 10, 11, 12

Special Schools/Groups

Class 1 4-10 years of age

Class 2 11-18 years of age

3. Entries

- Maximum size 51cm wide by 76cm high
- Any medium can be used i.e. paint, crayon, pen and ink, pencil and computer generated as long as the correct size is adhered to.
- Official entry forms must be completed in full in **BLOCK CAPITALS** and **affixed to the reverse of each painting**

4. Prizes

There will be up to fourteen prizes awarded

2. Entries which do not comply with the required specification will be rejected
